Renew your membership! Thanks to those who have already renewed. Membership is year to year, with renewals due the first of the year.

\$20 for one artist group (Craftmakers, Sculptors, Photographers, or Painters) and \$10 for the Collective for a total of **\$30.** Add \$20 for any additional artist group(s) you choose.

To **RENEW** your Membership or to **JOIN** for the first time: Go to https://www.centralcoastartistscollective.org Select **JOIN US.**

- Select "Join or Renew" in the first box. This is required.
- Enter your first and last name and your email address (required).
- Fill in the Optional fields. These are not necessary if you are renewing unless your information has changed.
- Check the boxes for the groups you wish to join. They may be the same or different from those to which you currently belong. Please check at least one of these boxes.
- The final step in the process before payment is to Save your information. This is a required step.
- After Saving, scroll down to the payment section. Select PayPal or Credit Card, Send a check by mail, or No payment-Exit.

Pay Pal or Credit Card

Select the number of Artist Groups.

PayPal: Enter the email and password for your PayPal account. The amount to be paid will be shown. Press "Review your Order." It will be placed and you will be returned to the Home page of the website.

Credit Card: If you prefer to use a credit card, scroll down past the request to enter your PayPal account. Select Pay by Credit or Debit Card. Follow the instructions.

I have recently had problems with my vision due to an eye disease. I can see out of one eye but can no longer drive so I have to take the bus to get around. This has put a real damper on my photography. I can do some photo taking within walking distance of my home in Pismo Beach and I go on photo tours with Don Quintana and other pro photographers occasionally.

When served lemons, make lemonade!





My Adventures with "Dronie"

There's no doubt that drones have had their fair share of controversy around them, and still have. In the past years most countries and regions have managed to implement some rules and laws which makes the use of drones more clear to the photographer for previously unreachable

angles, unique photos and fascinating perspectives on nature. With that in mind, I found the DJI Mini 3 Pro Drone and brought it to a workshop in the Badlands of Utah last September. In my presentation I'll tell you why I chose this particular drone as a beginner to capture my unworldly images plus share my trials and errors with you as well as the people who gave me inspiration to pursue drone photography.




