Hidden Horizon


I am a self-taught fine art photographer, using my camera as an initial tool to create abstract impressionistic images.

While most of my work is inspired by the natural world, nature is not a subject that I attempt to represent.


My process leads me to discover images not seen by most people. Shadows, light, reflections, and textures, are the elements with which I work.





Hearst Castle: Inside Edition By Amber Rack Central Coast Photographic Society

Meeting via Zoom November 9, 2023 @ 7 p.m. PST

When COVID-19 shut down in-person tours at Hearst Castle - and then damage to the access road extended the closure - Amber found herself working in the monument's photography archives for a full two years. In that time, she made significant progress organizing the extensive collection of negatives, prints, slides, and digital photos; and she also generated a great deal of social media content. For this presentation, she's combed through hundreds of her own images to create an insider look at views, rooms, and objects visitors to the Castle rarely (or never) have an opportunity to see.

Amber Rack was born in San Luis Obispo but raised in Washington State. She began practicing photography more than 30 years ago, in high school. After moving from Seattle to California at the end of 2015, Amber took the opportunity to use her photography skills with the State Parks: first at Calaveras Big Trees and then at Hearst Castle, where she found herself working in the photo & media archives while the monument was closed. Her images from Hearst Castle have been used in travel publications, scholarly articles, and for conservation purposes. She also contributed a great deal of content for Hearst Castle's social media on Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, and YouTube.




