CCAC Artist Group Membership for 2024

Renew your membership! Thanks to those who have already renewed. Membership is year to year, with renewals due the first of the year.

\$20 for one artist group (Craftmakers, Sculptors, Photographers, or Painters) and \$10 for the Collective for a total of **\$30.** Add \$20 for any additional artist group(s) you choose.

To **RENEW** your Membership or to **JOIN** for the first time: Go to https://www.centralcoastartistscollective.org Select **JOIN US.**

- Select "Join or Renew" in the first box. This is required.
- Enter your first and last name and your email address (required).
- Fill in the Optional fields. These are not necessary if you are renewing unless your information has changed.
- Check the boxes for the groups you wish to join. They may be the same or different from those to which you currently belong. Please check at least one of these boxes.
- The final step in the process before payment is to Save your information. This is a required step.
- After Saving, scroll down to the payment section. Select PayPal or Credit Card, Send a check by mail, or No payment-Exit.

Pay Pal or Credit Card

Select the number of Artist Groups.

PayPal: Enter the email and password for your PayPal account. The amount to be paid will be shown. Press "Review your Order." It will be placed and you will be returned to the Home page of the website.

Credit Card: If you prefer to use a credit card, scroll down past the request to enter your PayPal account. Select Pay by Credit or Debit Card. Follow the instructions.

Clay sculpture is one of the oldest art forms on earth. I try to create something new and fresh in this medium. I also recently have been working in bronze.

I admire the simplicity, honesty and strength of primitive work. For me, simple can be both strong and beautiful as well as capable of eliciting an emotional response. Shape is everything. It's more about gesture than detail. This minimal approach can feel both primitive and contemporary... But, for me, in the end, it needs to feel fresh (some risk in execution) and have some attitude in its presence, for it to be successful.







- -When a professional quality photograph is needed.
- -When scanning is an option.
- -Why you should use a professional photographer to photograph your work including lighting, polarization, parallax, focus, exposure, lens and sensor quality, data and resolution, data transfer and post-production, and storage.
- -When and why you do not need a professional photographer to photograph your work. What is your minimum standard?

Chuck Jennings, BA, MFA, is renowned as a painter, photographer and educator. He was Chair of the Department of Art and Design at Cal Poly for 14 years before retiring. First a painter, he subsequently embraced photography as a focus for his art as well as professionally.




